<u>Waterworks Garden</u> - Waterworks Gardens is designed as a series of garden "rooms." The Knoll is the entry to Waterworks. The path then passes through a series of leaf-shaped ponds, an inlaid mosaic Grotto and wetlands. The gardens are open between dawn and dusk year-round.
